

3-Day Workshop on SEE Learning Concludes Successfully at DIET Leh

Leh, 13 December 2025: The District Institute of Education & Training (DIET), Leh, successfully concluded a transformative 3-Day Workshop on Social, Emotional, and Ethical (SEE) Learning today. The programme, conducted with the addition of Mr. Nishant Payal, Programme Manager Piramal Foundation who had joined as the Resource person from day 2 of the programme, including Mr. Dorjay Wangchuk, Sr. Lecturer DIET & Ms. Tsering Angmo Lecturer, DIET. During the sessions all the experts provided deep insights into the practical implementation of SEE Learning principles within the educational ecosystem.
