

## Various delegations call on LG Ladakh

Leh, January 2: Various delegations called on the Hon'ble Lieutenant Governor of Ladakh, Shri Kavinder Gupta, at the Lieutenant Governor's Secretariat today, and were reaffirmed of the UT Administration's commitment to the welfare of Ladakh's people with a focus on inclusivity and equal representation across communities.
