

Mimang-Si-sJabstogs Outreach Camps Successfully Held in Fotoksar, Fanjila, Hinju-Ursi, Hanupata, and Wanla Villages, KHALTSI Sub-Division

November 15, 2025: KHALTSI, Leh – The KHALTSI Sub-Division Administration successfully conducted the Mimang-Si-sJabstogs public outreach initiative today across five remote villages: Fotoksar, Fanjila, Hinju-Ursi, Hanupata, and Wanla. The multi-village camp brought essential government services directly to residents, ensuring efficient grievance redressal and scheme awareness.

The program witnessed strong participation from local communities. A dedicated team of officers from Revenue, Health, Agriculture, PHE, PDD, R&B, Animal Husbandry, Sheep Husbandry, Horticulture, Veterinary, Social Welfare, Rural Development, Food & Civil Supplies, and State Bank of India provided on-the-spot services, including health check-ups, certificate issuance, beneficiary registrations, document verification, and scheme enrolment.

Villagers raised concerns on road connectivity, drinking water, irrigation, and welfare entitlements. Minor issues were resolved immediately, while significant demands were documented for priority follow-up. Officials briefed residents on key government schemes and guided them on application procedures.

The Mimang-Si-sJabstogs initiative continues to bridge the gap between administration and remote communities, fostering trust and ensuring last-mile service delivery.

Residents expressed gratitude for the doorstep outreach. The Sub-Division Administration assured regular camps and swift action on all recorded grievances.
