

DC Leh Chairs Meeting on Telecom Connectivity Issues in Leh District

Leh, November 4, 2025: Deputy Commissioner, Leh, Romil Singh Donk, IAS, chaired a meeting today to review and assess the status of telecom connectivity in Leh district at the chamber of Deputy Commissioner's Office, Leh.

During the meeting, the DC Leh sought detailed information from the telecom service providers on why the network has not been fully set up, the challenges they are facing, and locations where towers have been installed. He also inquired about the number of proposals submitted by each telecom operator to enhance connectivity across the district.

DC Leh instructed all officers to submit a detailed village-wise report specifying areas with network issues, the service providers available, and the current stage of work completion. He directed that the report be submitted by 2:00 PM today for review.

The Deputy Commissioner further stated that he would connect with the SDMs after receiving the reports to discuss the connectivity gaps and coordinate necessary actions. He also informed that the next review meeting on telecom connectivity will be conducted within the next 5–6 days to evaluate the progress made.
