

UT Administration committed to address problems of general public: LG Ladakh Various delegations call on LG Ladakh

Leh, February 17: Various delegations called on the Hon'ble Lieutenant Governor of Ladakh, Shri Kavinder Gupta, at the LG Secretariat today and apprised him of several key issues related to employment, development, and tourism.

A delegation led by Member of Parliament from Ladakh, Shri Mohmad Haneefa Jan, discussed several issues with the Lt Governor.
