

LG Kavinder expresses gratitude to MHA, UPSC for advertisement of vacancies

Leh, September 9: The Hon'ble Lieutenant Governor of Ladakh, Shri Kavinder Gupta, expressed his gratitude to the Hon'ble Union Home Minister, Shri Amit Shah; the Union Home Secretary, Shri Govind Mohan, and the Union Public Service Commission (UPSC) for facilitating the advertisement of vacancies in the Administration of the Union Territory of Ladakh.

The Lieutenant Governor stated that the advertisement of posts is in line with the aspirations of the people of Ladakh, providing 80% reservation for Scheduled Tribes of Ladakh and 4% reservation for residents of areas adjoining the Actual Line of Control (ALC).
