

Launch of Three Major Agricultural Missions by Hon'ble Prime Minister – Live Telecast and Field Activities Held in Kargil

Kargil, October 11, 2025: The Hon'ble Prime Minister of India today launched three landmark agricultural missions — PM Dhan Dhanya Krishi Yojana, National Dalhan Mission, and the National Mission on Natural Farming — during a grand event held at Bharatratna C. Subramaniam Auditorium, NASC Complex, Pusa, New Delhi.

The event was witnessed live in Kargil by a gathering of progressive farmers, Self Help Group (SHG) members, and agriculture department staff at the Farmers' Training Hall, Kurbathang, where the live telecast of the Prime Minister's address was arranged.
