

Secretary, Higher Education, UT Ladakh, Reviews Enrolment, Academic and Infrastructure Facilities at GDC Nobra.

April 22, 2026: The Secretary, Higher Education UT Ladakh, Ms. Bhanu Prabha, IAS conducted an official visit to Government Degree College (GDC) Nobra on 22nd April to review the overall functioning of the institution, with a particular focus on student enrolment, academic performance, and infrastructural development.
