

7-Day Multi-Speciality MMU Camp Concludes at Singayllok Block.

Khaltse, June 30, 2025: The seven-day Multi-Speciality Medical Mobile Unit (MMU) camp, organized by the Block Medical Officer (BMO) Khaltse, Dr. Shamim Ahmad, successfully concluded on June 29, 2025. The camp covered remote villages of the Singayllok block, including Photoksar, Youlchung, Nyraks, Skumpata, Lingshed, and Dipling.

The camp delivered a comprehensive range of healthcare services, including general consultations, gynecological and pediatric care, dental and ophthalmic services, non-communicable disease (NCD) counseling, laboratory diagnostics, Adolescent-Friendly Health Clinic (AFHC) counseling, physiotherapy, RBSK screening, and CBNAAT testing.

A total of 532 patients benefited from the healthcare services during in seven days camp, including:

211 General OPD consultations,

81 Dental OPD consultations,

89 Gynecology consultations,

151 Pediatric consultations,

180 Ophthalmic consultations,

53 AFHC counseling sessions,

249 NCD screenings,

81 Physiotherapy sessions,

136 RBSK screenings and

85 CBNAAT tests.

In addition, 477 laboratory tests were conducted.

To promote holistic well-being, seven yoga sessions were organized across various villages, with 262 participants actively taking part.

The camp was successfully implemented with the support of a dedicated team of medical professionals, including:
