

SDM, Khaltse chaired a meeting regarding regulation of Traffic and Cleanliness in the Khaltse Market.

Khaltse, April 10, 2025: With the onset of the summer season and the consequent increase in traffic movement in the Khaltse Market area, the Sub-Divisional Magistrate (SDM) Khaltse, Mohd Sharief, convened a meeting with concerned officers and stakeholders to discuss traffic regulation and cleanliness measures, on yesterday April 09, 2025.

The meeting featured a comprehensive discussion on streamlining traffic flow and maintaining cleanliness in and around Khaltse Market. It was decided that shopkeepers will not be allowed to park their vehicles near their shops within the market area.

The SDM directed the concerned officers to take effective measures to ensure the smooth flow of traffic and maintain hygiene. He emphasized the importance of implementing speed limit signboards, regulating parking time within the market, designating proper parking areas, and using 'No Parking' stickers to facilitate better vehicle movement and reduce congestion.
