

ADC Leh Chairs Meeting to Review Regulation and Monitoring of LPG Cylinders in Leh

The ADC also directed all concerned officers to maintain close coordination for effective implementation. He stressed the importance of submitting daily progress reports and conducting regular inspections to ensure the proper and fair use of LPG cylinders.
