

Fire Destroys 11 Shops in Skalzangling, Authorities Pledge Support

Leh, February 27: A devastating fire broke out in Skalzangling around 3:00 AM, destroying 11 shops and causing significant financial losses to the shopkeepers. Many of these business owners rely on their shops for their livelihoods, making this a severe setback for them and their families.
