

Leh, February 5, 2025. The Deputy Commissioner of Leh, Santosh Sukhadeve, chaired a meeting of the District Level Committee to review Time Bound Promotions, Functional Promotions, and Compassionate Appointments under SRO-43. The meeting was held at the VC Room of the DC Office, Leh, and was attended by key officials including Additional Deputy Commissioner Ghulam Mohd., Deputy Director Employment Leh Delex Namgyal, Headquarter Assistant Rigzin Yangdol, and Heads of various Departments

During the meeting, the Deputy Commissioner approved a total of 13 Time Bound Promotions and 8 Functional Promotions across various departments. In the Revenue Department, 6 Time Bound Promotions were granted, while the Food, Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs (FCS&CA) Department saw 2 such promotions. The District Motor Garages Department received 5 Time Bound Promotions, and the Education Department was granted 12 Time Bound Promotions along with 5 Functional Promotions. Additionally, the Rural Development Department was awarded 12 Time Bound Promotions, and the Sheep Husbandry Department received 3.

In terms of Functional Promotions, the Public Works Department (PWD) was granted 2 promotions, and the Agriculture Department received 1. Furthermore, compassionate appointments were approved, with 1 case from the Chief Education Office and 1 from the Public Health Engineering (PHE) Department.

The Deputy Commissioner emphasized the importance of timely submission of promotion cases and instructed all Heads of Departments (HoDs) to ensure compliance. He also directed that compassionate appointments be reviewed thoroughly to ensure transparency and fairness

The meeting concluded with a commitment to expedite the promotion process and address pending cases in a time-bound manner. The Deputy Commissioner reiterated the administration's dedication to employee welfare and efficient governance.
