

Delegation from Darchik Garkon calls on LG Kavinder

Leh, November 28: A delegation from Darchik-Garkon, led by Nominated Councillor Rigzen Gurmet, today called on the Hon'ble Lieutenant Governor of Ladakh, Shri Kavinder Gupta, to flag several pressing developmental and administrative concerns affecting their region.

Councillor Gurmet highlighted the urgent interventions in the Darchik–Garkon belt, which forms one of the most culturally significant and geographically sensitive areas of Ladakh. He stressed that residents of the Aryan Valley continue to face hardships, and sought targeted interventions for their welfare.
