

Singe Tsangspo Tsangde Lasgul – Clean Up Indus River Campaign” Successfully Conducted in Nyoma Sub Division

Nyoma, August 12, 2025 – In a dedicated effort to preserve and rejuvenate the sacred waters of Indus River, a large-scale cleanliness drive titled “Singe Tsangspo Tsangde Lasgul” (Let’s Clean the Indus River) was successfully organized on 12th August 2025 in Nyoma sub division under the leadership of Sub-Divisional Magistrate (SDM) Kacho Asgar.
