

Hon'ble Lt Governor Brig (Dr) BD Mishra (Retd) hosts Iftar party in Kargil

Kargil, March 19, 2025: The Hon'ble Lieutenant Governor of Ladakh, Brigadier (Dr) BD Mishra (Retd) and First Lady, Smt Neelam Mishra today hosted an Iftar Party in Kargil for religious heads, political leaders and Administrative Officials.

The party was attended by Chairman/Chief Executive Councillor, LAHDC, Kargil, Dr Mohd Jaffer Akhoon; Executive Councillor, Agha Syed Mujtaba; Executive Councillor, Kacho Mohd Feroz; Executive Councillor, Er. Punchok Tashi; heads of religious institutions; Councillors of LAHDC; Directors, Joint Directors and District Officers.

Greeting everyone on the occasion of holy month of Ramazan, the HLG stated that the Prophet Mohammad (SAW) ordained the people with five noble duties, one among which is fasting in the month of Ramazan.
