Kargil, January 21, 2025: The Hon'ble Lieutenant Governor of Ladakh, Brigadier (Dr) BD Mishra (Retd) and First Lady, Smt. Neelam Mishra today attended a function at Tourist Facilitation Centre, Kargil to celebrate the Foundation Day of Manipur, Meghalaya and Tripura.
