

GOC-in-C Northern Command calls on LG Ladakh; discusses current situation in Leh

Leh, September 27: The General Officer Commanding-in-Chief (GOC-in-C) of the Indian Army's Northern Command, Lieutenant General Pratik Sharma, today called on the Hon'ble Lieutenant Governor of Ladakh, Shri Kavinder Gupta, and discussed the prevailing situation in Leh.
