

District-Level Workshop on Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission (ABDM) Successfully Conducted at DC Conference Hall, Leh

February 15, 2025 Leh – The Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission (ABDM), UT Ladakh, successfully organized a district-level workshop on February 15, 2025, at the DC Conference Hall, Leh. The event brought together healthcare professionals, officials, and stakeholders to review the progress of ABDM implementation and discuss strategies for further strengthening digital healthcare initiatives in the Leh district.

The event also highlighted the significant progress in the Health Professional Registry (HPR), with 100% of doctors and 90% of nurses registered in the district.

A major focus was placed on the increasing adoption of ABHA (Ayushman Bharat Health Account) across healthcare facilities, with notable improvements observed at CHC Disket, PHC Basgo, and Block Khaltsi. The workshop also celebrated the successful linkage of ABHA with other public health programs, showcasing the mission's impact on improving healthcare outcomes.

The event concluded with an award ceremony honoring healthcare facilities and blocks for their outstanding contributions to ABDM implementation. The workshop underscored the collective efforts of all stakeholders in driving the digital transformation of healthcare in the region and reaffirmed the commitment to achieving the mission's goals.
