

Monlam Chenmo Draws 1,700 Monks and Nuns to Dharma Centre During Sacred Relics Exposition

Leh, May 14: The Dharma Centre at Choglamsar on Thursday witnessed a large gathering of monks, nuns and devotees during the observance of Monlam Chenmo organised by the Ladakh Gonpa Association (LGA) as part of the ongoing Sacred Exposition of the Holy Relics of the Tathagata Buddha.

Nearly 1,700 monks and nuns participated in the grand prayer congregation held in the sacred presence of the Holy Relics following the auspicious arrival of the Relics from Zanskar. The prayers were led in the presence of H.E. Tsamtul Rinpoche, H.E. Drukpa Thuksey Rinpoche and H.E.
