

Mass Awareness Program on Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking held in Trespone

Kargil, February 07, 2026: The Youth Educational Society Trespone, in collaboration with the District De-Addiction Centre (DDAC) Kargil, religious organizations (IKMT and JUIAKL), and Police Station Sankoo, organized an important Mass Awareness Program on Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking at Panchayat Ghar-A, Trespone, Kargil.
