

CEC Kargil Welcomes New Hajj Committee, Assures Land for Hajj House

Kargil, May 18, 2026: Chairman and Chief Executive Councillor, LAHDC Kargil, Dr. Mohd Jaffer Akhoo, today welcomed the newly appointed members of the Hajj Committee at the Council Secretariat, Kargil.
