

EC Education Attends Annual Day Celebration of Govt. Model Middle School Gramthang

Kargil, September 11, 2025: Executive Councillor for Education, LAHDC Kargil, Zakir Hussain today attended the Annual Day Celebration of Govt. Model Middle School, Gramthang, Minjee.

The event was graced by Director School Education, Ladakh, Tashi Dolma; Assistant Commissioner Revenue, Kargil, Jahangir Akhoun; Councillor Baroo-Minjee, Adv.
