

Various delegations call on LG Ladakh

Leh, Dec 8: Various delegations called on the Hon'ble Lieutenant Governor of Ladakh, Shri Kavinder Gupta, at the Lieutenant Governor's Secretariat today, discussing industrial initiatives, infrastructure, cultural preservation, social welfare, and economic opportunities.

A delegation from the Confederation of Indian Industry (CII) met with the Lieutenant Governor and submitted their demands.
