

## **Chief Secretary Ashish Kundra chairs meeting on Citizen-Centric Urban Mobility Audit in Ladakh**

Leh, May 19, 2026: The Chief Secretary of the UT Ladakh, Ashish Kundra, today chaired a meeting to discuss the audit for assessing ease of urban mobility from a citizen-centric perspective in the UT of Ladakh.
