

Lt Governor Ladakh meets Prime Minister Narendra Modi *Discusses issues concerning general public, developmental priorities*

New Delhi, Jan 5: The Lieutenant Governor of the Union Territory of Ladakh, Shri Kavinder Gupta, today met Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi in New Delhi and held detailed discussions on the overall development and welfare of the region.
