

## CEC Kargil Flags Off Water Tankers to Boost Drinking Water Facilities in District Kargil

Kargil, June 28, 2025 - In a major step toward improving essential public services in the region, Chairman and Chief Executive Councillor of LAHDC Kargil, Dr. Mohd Jaffer Akhoo, today flagged off three water tankers to enhance drinking water supply in Kargil.

The vehicles were commissioned under the Special Development Package (SDP) and the Water Tax Revenue sector, facilitated through the Public Health Engineering (PHE) Department, Kargil Division.

Addressing the gathering at the flag-off ceremony, Dr. Akhoo highlighted the significance of the initiative, especially in light of the increased water demand during the holy month of Muharram.
