

Deputy Commissioner Leh Santosh Sukhdeve Reviews Progress of Leh Bhawan in Dwarka, New Delhi

New Delhi, 04 March 25: Today, Deputy Commissioner Leh, Santosh Sukhdeve, conducted a comprehensive site visit to the ongoing construction of the Leh Bhawan in Dwarka, New Delhi. The purpose of his visit was to assess the on-ground progress to ensure that the project remains on track for its scheduled completion by 2027.

The Leh Bhawan, with a project cost of Rs. 31.05 Crore will have a total of 28 guest rooms. These include 2 double-bedded suites, 17 double-bedded rooms, 4 twin-bedded guest rooms, 3 triple-bedded guest rooms. It will also include 2 dormitories which add 13 more beds to the facility. The total capacity of the Leh Bhawan will be 68 beds, providing the much required accommodation solution for residents from Leh visiting New Delhi, particularly those seeking medical purposes or educational opportunities.

Dy Commissioner Sukhdeve directed all officials involved to ensure that the project adheres to the highest standards of quality and is completed within the stipulated timeframe.

Officials of the Central Public Works Department, Public Works Department, the concerned contractor were also present during the visit.
