

## **CEC Kargil Lauds Poyen School Upgradation, Announces Fair Teacher Transfer Policy & Infrastructural Funds**

Kargil, November 04, 2025: Chairman and Chief Executive Councillor (CEC), LAHDC Kargil, Dr. Mohd Jaffer Akhoon, attended the Annual Day celebration of Government PM Shri Higher Secondary School Poyen today.
