

Chief Secretary reviews arrangements for the Sacred Buddha Relics Exposition at Jive-Tsal

Leh, 06 March 2026: Following the UT-level coordination committee meeting, the Chief Secretary of the Union Territory of Ladakh, Ashish Kundra, today visited Jive-Tsal, Choglamsar, to inspect and review the preparations being made for the upcoming Holy Exposition of the Sacred Buddha Relics, scheduled to begin on May 1.

During the visit, the Chief Secretary assessed the preparedness at the venue and reviewed the ongoing arrangements related to infrastructure, crowd management, security, sanitation, parking facilities, and overall logistical support for the large number of devotees and tourists expected to attend the sacred exposition.

The inspection aimed to ensure that all necessary arrangements are in place well in advance for the smooth conduct of the Holy Exposition, which is expected to draw a large gathering of devotees, pilgrims, and tourists from across the country and abroad.
