

Workshop on TSA/TSA Hybrid for Accounts Personnel of UT Ladakh

Leh, September 22: The Finance Department, UT Ladakh, in collaboration with the office of the Controller General of Accounts (CGA), Ministry of Home Affairs, organized a three-day workshop-cum-handholding session on Treasury Single Account (TSA) and TSA Hybrid for accounts personnel of Leh and Kargil districts. The workshop is being held from September 22 to 24, 2025, in the Conference Hall of the DC Office, Leh.

The sessions are aimed at providing detailed insights and training on the end-to-end process flow of TSA operations. The program was inaugurated in the presence of Dr. Latinkhuma Franklin, IAS, Secretary Finance and Director Accounts and Treasuries (DAT), UT Ladakh, who emphasized the importance of TSA in ensuring greater transparency and efficiency in financial management. The workshop also marked a significant milestone with the signing of an agreement between the Directorate of Accounts and Treasuries, Ladakh, and the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) for the opening of the TSA account in RBI.

Training sessions were led by Ms. Gayetri Devi, Sr. Accounts Officer, and Mr. Ashutosh, Assistant Accounts Officer, CGA, along with officials from RBI including Mr. Gabas Biswas, General Manager, DGBA, and Mr. Atul Kumar Dass, Manager, DGBA. From the Ministry of Home Affairs, the workshop was attended by Shri H. Atheli, Joint CGA, and Mr. Anupam Raj, Deputy CGA, who also addressed the gathering. The sessions witnessed participation from Joint Directors Finance, Chief Accounts Officers, Accounts Officers, and Assistant Accounts Officers from various HoD offices, PAO offices, and the UT Secretariat.

The inaugural session featured a welcome address by the Pay and Accounts Officer, Leh, followed by remarks from dignitaries, highlighting the crucial role of TSA in strengthening Ladakh's financial governance. The three-day program will conclude with a comprehensive handholding session to ensure smooth adoption and implementation of TSA/TSA Hybrid across the Union Territory.
