

ADC Kargil Attends LOA's District-Level Archery Tournament at Khri Sultan Cho Stadium

Kargil, February 19, 2026: The Additional Deputy Commissioner Kargil Imteeaz Kacho attended the District-Level Archery Tournament (2026) organized by the Ladakh Olympic Association (LOA), Kargil held at the Khri Sultan Cho Sports Stadium, Byamathang.
