

CEC Kargil Lays Foundation Stone for ₹13 Crore Finance Complex at Kurbathang

Kargil, July 10, 2024 - In a significant development for the region, Chairman and Chief Executive Councillor of Ladakh Autonomous Hill Development Council (LAHDC) Kargil, Dr. Mohd Jaffer Akhoo, laid the foundation stone for the construction of a modern Finance Complex at Kurbathang, Kargil.
