

LG Kavinder Gupta chairs high-level security review meeting in Ladakh

Leh, October 4: The Hon'ble Lieutenant Governor of Ladakh, Shri Kavinder Gupta, today chaired a high-level security review meeting to assess the prevailing security scenario in UT Ladakh.
