

DC Leh Convenes Meeting to Review Dharti Aaba Abhiyan in Leh District

Leh, July 10, 2025: The Deputy Commissioner Leh, Romil Singh Donk (IAS), chaired a meeting to oversee the progress of the Dharti Aaba Abhiyan across all blocks of Leh District on July 10, in VC Room, DC office Leh.

During the meeting, Additional District Development Commissioner (ADDC) Sonam Norbu reviewed all the progress of Dharti Aaba Janjatiya Gram Utkarsh Abhiyan and instructed all Sub-Divisional Magistrates to further direct their Child Development Project Officers (CDPOs) to report and update scheme data on the portal, including pictures, as they are the nodal officers.

It was highlighted that so far, 67 camps have been recorded in the district. These camps successfully raised awareness among the local public and provided benefits from schemes such as the Golden Card, health card, domicile certificates, Vishwakarma scheme, financial literacy and other government schemes. He further instructed that camps in the remaining villages be completed within the given time framework.

DC Leh further directed all the officers that TB screening for general public be implemented with greater emphasis under the "Month of Compassion," alongside awareness camps for the Ujjwala Abhiyan. He also urged all SDMs to identify schemes with zero data under Dharti Aaba Janjatiya Gram Utkarsh Abhiyan on their charts and prioritize them in their respective areas, ensuring timely updates with pictures on the portal.

The meeting was attended by ADDC Leh Sonam Norbu, Assistant Commissioner Development AG Zargar, CPO Tsewang Gyalson, CMO Leh, Chief Animal Husbandry Officer, Executive Officer MC Leh, Lead Bank Manager, and other officers and officials. All SDMs attended the meeting through VC.
