

386 candidates appear for 111 vacancies in 10+2 contractual lecturers' examination in Kargil

Kargil, March 09, 2025: The 10+2 contractual lecturers' examination was successfully held today across multiple centers in Kargil district. The examination took place at Govt. Degree College, Kargil, Boys Hostel Channi, Jammu, and Higher Secondary School, Padum, Zanskar.

In attendance at the examination were Chief Education Officer (CEO) Kargil, S.D. Namgial; Deputy Director Employment, Khazada Muhammad Usman; Superintendent Examination Abid Hussain; Principal ITI Kargil; Deputy Superintendent Examination, and several other officials from Education Department, Kargil.
