

Mukul Beniwal, IAS Assumes Charge as Deputy Commissioner, Nubra, Stanzin Losal, JKPS joins as Superintendent of Police, Nubra.

Nubra, April 29, 2026: Mukul Beniwal, IAS, today assumed charge as the Deputy Commissioner of Nubra, while Stanzin Losal, JKPS, joined as the Superintendent of Police, Nubra.
