

Farmers in Stok Village Trained on Nutri-Cereal Cultivation

Leh, September 13, 2025: A training camp focusing on nutri-cereal cultivation was held today, September 13, 2025, in Stok village, Leh. The event, organized by the Agriculture Department under the National Food Security Mission (NFSM), aimed to educate farmers on the best practices for growing crops like buckwheat, millets, and barley.
