

Dharti Aaba Jan Bhagidari Abhiyan Concludes in Kargil with Focus on Community Outreach

Kargil, July 15, 2025 — The month-long Dharti Aaba Jan Bhagidari Abhiyan, Awareness and Benefit Saturation Camp 2025 concluded successfully in Kargil with a formal closing ceremony held at the Auditorium Hall.

The event was attended by Executive Councillor for Tourism Kacho Mohammad Feroz, Executive Councillor for Agriculture Aga Syed Mujtaba, Deputy Commissioner and CEO LAHDC Kargil Rakesh Kumar, SSP Kargil Shri Ram R., along with officials from various departments.

In his address as Chief Guest, Executive Councillor Kacho Mohd Feroz lauded the efforts of the district administration and line departments for conducting the campaign effectively. He highlighted community participation as a core pillar of the initiative and noted that beneficiaries were not only registered but also made aware of various government schemes.
