

District Commissioner Santosh Sukhadeve's Visit to Lankor and Igoo Villages to Review Land Digitization Process under DILRMP

Leh, January 18, 2025 – District Commissioner (DC) Santosh Sukhadeve visited Lankor village in Igoo Panchayat and Igoo village to review the draft publication of land digitization under the Digital India Land Records Modernization Programme (DILRMP). The visit was aimed at assessing the progress and finalizing the land records digitization process for the region.

During the visit to Lankor village, the officials from Kharu Block presented a superimposed map showing the rough location, land parcel map, and digitized photos, which were finalized based on the ETS map of Lakung Village.

During the visit, the Namberder and villagers of Lankor raised several community concerns. The villagers, including representatives from the Women's Association, requested the establishment of a medical aid center, a food bridge, and improved transportation services. They specifically highlighted the need for a bus service to address transportation challenges faced by the residents. Additionally, the women's society requested the construction of a dedicated center for women's activities.

DC Santosh Sukhadeve assured the people of Lankor that their concerns were valid and addressed their basic necessities. He emphasized the importance of land digitization, stating that it would make land-related services more accessible. With digitized records, residents would no longer need to travel long distances to check land documents or address related issues, as the information would be easily accessible online via mobile phones. He also expressed that this process would help reduce time and improve efficiency for the villagers in resolving land-related concerns.

On his return journey, DC Sukhadeve visited Igoo, where the Patwari and other officials were conducting fieldwork related to land digitization. He expressed his gratitude to the field workers for their dedicated efforts and assured the concerned officials of any support they might need to continue their work.
