

## **Director, PMO Sweta Singh (IFS) chaired a Review meeting of Vibrant Village Programme Implementation in Leh District**

Leh, July 15, 2025: As part of the ongoing efforts to evaluate and accelerate the implementation of the Vibrant Village Programme in the Union Territory of Ladakh, Ms. Sweta Singh (IFS), Director, Prime Minister's Office chaired a high-level review meeting today at the Conference Hall, DC Office Leh.
