Kargil, Feb 04, 2025: Vice-Chancellor, University of Ladakh (UoL), Prof. Saket Kushwaha, today visited Kargil Campus at Khumbathang, where he received a warm welcome by the students, faculty and non-teaching staff of the Campus. During the interactive session the teaching, non-teaching and students of the campus also spoke and highlighted the issues faced by them.

While speaking on the occasion, Prof. Saket Kushwaha said he will stay along with his office two days a week in Kargil Campus and assured them that all the concerns will be examined and needful will be done as per established norms.

Later, the Vice Chancellor visited School of Agriculture Science and Technology, Kargil Campus, UoL where he was warmly welcomed by Chief Scientist and Head School of Agriculture Science and Technology, Dr Faizan Ahmed, faculty members, staff and students
