

Lama Chodpa Tsogs and Kusali Chod Offered at Jive-Tsal as Public Veneration Concluded in Leh

Leh, May 10: As public veneration of the Sacred Relics of the Tathagata Buddha concluded in Leh, Jive-Tsal continued to resonate with prayers, offerings and sacred chants marking the final spiritual observances of the exposition period.

Members of Nalden Nyamlen Tsogspa Lalok, led by Drupon Phuntsok Gyalsen Rinpoche along with more than a hundred disciples, offered Lama Chodpa tsogs and Kusali Chod prayers at the sacred venue.
